
Lohri Celebration at SISJMPS

## "Experiment, Explore, Excel A Step Towards Scientific Brilliance!"

#### **ATAL Tinkering Lab Workshops**

"Basics of Electronics with Advanced Prototypes" at ATAL Tinkering Lab

A workshop on "Basics of Electronics with Advanced Prototypes" was conducted for Govt Sr. Sec. School Sighar (Vocational Stream) on 16th January, 2025 as a Community Visit at our ATL to introduce participants about fundamental electronic concepts and demonstrate the development of advanced prototypes. Resource Persons of the day were Mr. Kamaldeep Singh, Eknoor Bawa 7th C, Raninnder Sharma 7th C, Shehbaz Singh Benipal 7th A, Harmanjot Singh 8th C. The session began with a thorough explanation of basic electronic components such as resistors, capacitors. diodes, and transistors. Participants learnt how these components function in circuits and their practical applications. In this workshop more advanced topics were also highlighted such as focusing on prototyping with microcontrollers, sensors, and actuators. Hands-on sessions allowed the attendees to design and build prototypes using platforms like Arduino and Raspberry Pi. The importance of circuit simulation software and troubleshooting techniques was also emphasized.20 Students from Vocational Electrical Branch took part in this workshop along with their two Lecturers Mrs. Ramandeep Kaur and Mrs. Harpreet Kaur. At the end of the workshop, participants gained a solid understanding of both theoretical and practical aspects of electronics, as well as skills to create more sophisticated electronic projects. The interactive nature of the workshop enabled participants to ask questions and work on real-world examples, enhancing their learning experience.


