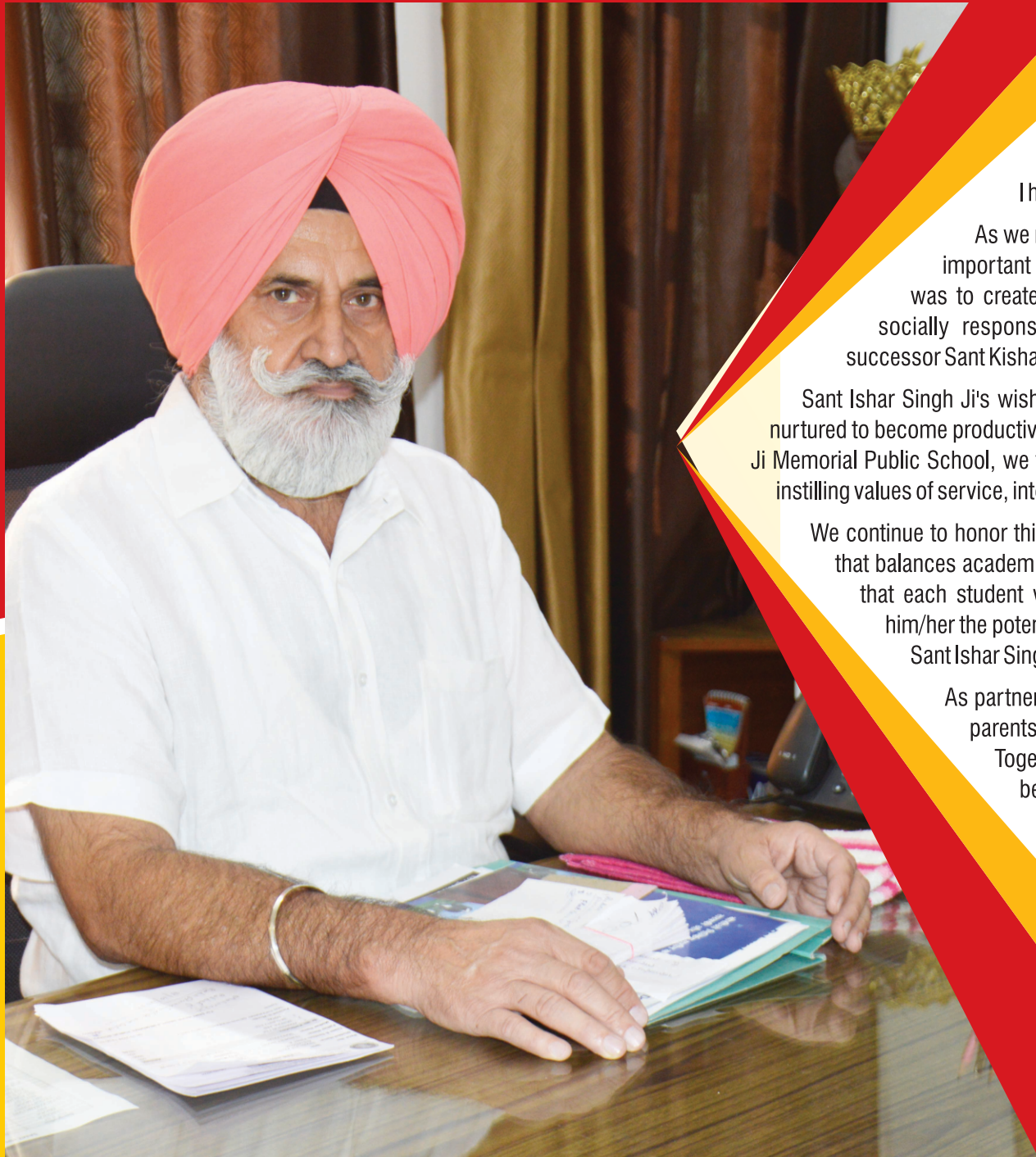

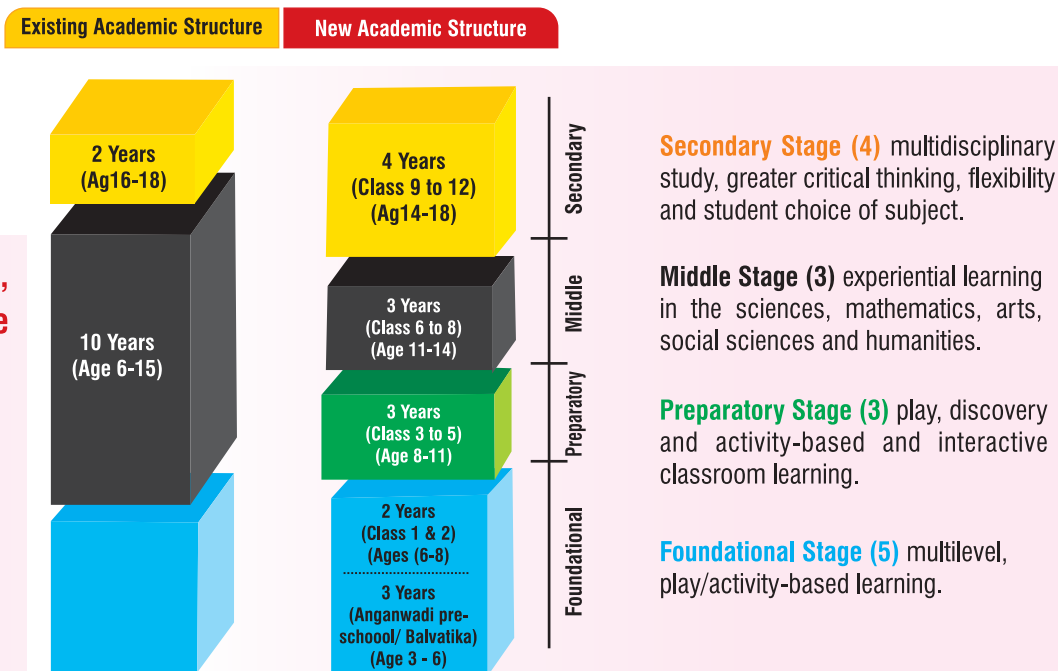

We prioritize competency-based learning, focusing beyond academic achievements to develop practical skills crucial for success. Our curriculum cultivates:

21st Century skills: - Critical-thinking, problem-solving, Creative Thinking, innovation, Adaptability & Resilience

Ensuring students excel in various aspects of life, our education emphasizes on Holistic development, Real-world applications, essential skills for a dynamic world.

Transforming Curricular & Pedagogical Structure



IMPLEMENTATION OF NEP IN SISJMPS

1. **Curriculum Changes:** Schools are adapting to the 5+3+3+4 structure by updating curricula to incorporate activity-based and experiential learning, while ensuring foundational literacy and numeracy for younger students.
2. **Teacher Training:** Schools are investing in teacher training to familiarize educators with new pedagogies, the integration of technology, and student-centric assessment methods.
3. **Language Policy:** Efforts are being made to teach in the local language up to Grade 5, where possible, which requires trained teachers and updating resources accordingly.
4. **Assessment and Evaluation:** Schools are gradually shifting to a formative assessment model, which focuses on regular, competency-based evaluations rather than just annual exams.
5. **Vocational and Skill-based Learning:** Schools are beginning to introduce vocational subjects as early as Grade 6, offering students practical skills and work-based learning opportunities.
6. **Focus on Inclusivity:** Special programs are being developed to ensure education for children with disabilities and those from socio-economically disadvantaged backgrounds, promoting equity in access to quality education.

NEP 2020 aims for a gradual transformation of the education system, and its successful implementation requires collaboration between schools, teachers, government bodies, and parents.

The Curriculum

- The School Academic Session extends from April to March.
- The course of studies is based on the syllabus prescribed by the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi. The school curriculum is not only stimulating but also extremely accurate in its approach.
- The school follows the three-language formula suggested in the NEP 2020, with English as the medium of instruction and Punjabi and Hindi as additional languages.
- The education at the SISJMPS is liberal and universal but at the same time it is Indian and firmly rooted in Indian history and tradition.
- The curriculum therefore embraces English (literature & composition), Punjabi, Hindi (literature & composition), Social Studies, Mathematics, Science, IT up-to class 10th. For standard 11th & 12th – Humanities, Medical, Non-medical & Commerce.
- Art & Craft, Games, Music & Physical education along with vocational courses & IT are also included in the curriculum.

Personality Development

Apart from classroom learning, Workshops, Outings, Guest lectures, Inter house and Inter-school competitions & celebrations of festivals are arranged so that students are exposed to varied and stimulating experiences for their overall personality growth. The school provides Personality Development Sessions' to its students from grade 6th onwards.

Counseling Session

A healthy, stable, and content mind functions without anxiety. The counseling sessions initiated by the school are designed to assist children with emotional and behavioral issues. Support is also provided to those experiencing learning difficulties, such as children with dyslexia and attention deficit disorders.



COURSES OF STUDY

The school prepares students for All India Secondary School Examination conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi. The school has classes from Pre-Nursery to Class XII. The medium of instructions is English for all the classes but school lays an equal emphasis on Hindi and Punjabi also. The subjects that are taught in the normal curriculum from classes Pre-Nursery to Class XII are as follows:

History, Civics, Geography, Economics, Computer Studies
Dance, Art & Craft, Sports & Physical Education.

SYLLABUS OF ASSESSMENT:

Please note that the syllabus of the assessment for admission has been designed by a professional team of educationists and psychologists to make it stress free for children.

AGE CRITERIA AS PER THE NEP (NEW EDUCATION POLICY 2020)

The eligibility criterion for various classes is based on the age of the child. For the next academic year the applicant's age as on 31st March 2025, as recorded in the birth certificate will determine the eligibility for admission to a particular class.

Recommended classes for children born between the following dates:

AGE ON MARCH 31, 2025

Nursery	3 Years
LKG	4 Years
UKG	5 Years
Class I	6 Years
Class II	7 Years



FEE DETAILS

- The fees will be charged as under:-
- Fees for Quarter-1 i.e. April, May and June are to be paid by last date of Admission given by the school.
- Fees for Quarter-2 i.e. July, August and September along with Examination Fee are to be paid in July till 10 July.
- Fees for Quarter-3 i.e. October, November and December are to be paid in October till 10 October.
- Fees for Quarter-4 i.e. January, February and March along with Examination Fee are to be paid in January till 10 January.

NOTE:

A fine of Rs.10/- per day will be charged for late fee payment if the fee is not paid up to 15th of the first month of quarter.

SCHOOL LEAVING CERTIFICATE

If a student wants to have a school-leaving certificate issued, the parent/guardian must apply for it at least one month in advance. The school fees for that quarter in which the certificate is required will be deposited.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Updated School uniform can be confirmed from the School office from time to time. Non-Compliance to the prescribed uniform and pattern of dress will lead to immediate suspension from School till the acceptable outfit is worn.



GENERAL RULES

Documents to be submitted at the time of admission:

1. School leaving/transfer certificate and previous year's Report Card (without this no student from Class II onwards will be admitted).
2. Birth Certificate, in original, to be brought for verification only.
3. Recent passport size color photograph of the candidate and both the parents.
4. Admission will be cancelled if any variance is found between the particulars filled in the Registration Form and the documents submitted for admission.
5. Copy of Aadhar Card of the candidate.
6. Copy of Aadhar card of both the parents.

The amount deposited towards registration and admission for a particulars neither refundable nor transferable to any other year.

ATTENDANCE & DISCIPLINE

- ✓ Regular attendance is an important requirement for successful results; a written application for leave must be submitted well in advance. In case of illness and other unforeseen circumstances, the parent/guardian should inform the Principal in writing as soon as possible. A certain minimum attendance of the total working days is required during the academic year, falling short of which the student will not be allowed to take the examination in that very year.
- ✓ The name of a student who is absent for 15 days without leave shall be struck off the roll. On re-admission, re-admission fee will be charged.
- ✓ A student whose name has been struck off for absence without leave and who is habitually late or persistently careless or indisciplined may not be re-admitted to the school.
- ✓ Every student must be present on the re-opening day after each vacation.
- ✓ It is advisable to ensure that a student is not disturbed during examination days and is not asked to attend a family function.
- ✓ No student can leave the school premises during school hours without the written permission of the Principal, which may be granted under exceptional circumstances, based on a written request from parents.

- ✓ The Principal has the right to suspend a student. The Principal may instruct/suggest/advise parents/guardians to withdraw their child from the school if his/her conduct during educational progress is not satisfactory.
- ✓ All entries of absence, late-coming and half-day leave should be made in the school diary and not on a sheet of paper.

PARENTAL CO-OPERATION

- ✓ Parents are required to look into their child's school diary every day and the homework assigned for the next day will be done regularly and diary must be countersigned by the parents.
- ✓ If you feel that you want to know more about your child, please do not hesitate to contact class-teacher.
- ✓ Criticism of a student's teacher and his/her school in the presence of the child should be avoided because it may cause the student to disrespect the student's school and teacher.
- ✓ Parents are not allowed to meet their children or their teachers during school hours without prior permission of the Principal.
- ✓ Parents are requested to inform the school of any change of address and contact number.
- ✓ Parents are required to send their children to school in time. Presence of every child in the assembly is compulsory.
- ✓ The child who fails to reach the school in time and does not attend the assembly may be sent back home.
- ✓ Parents should not take the child out of the school without prior permission from the Principal.
- ✓ No sick child may be sent to school with medicines during the school hours.
- ✓ Children will not be allowed to go home from school in between the school hours.

Please ensure that your ward takes part in all the activities of the school.

DISMISAL

A child may be expelled from the school on the following grounds:-

- Misbehavior with Principal, Vice-Principal or any Teaching or non-teaching Staff of the school.
- Absence from the class for more than prescribed days.
- Against proven disciplinary actions in the school premises or with the school students.
- A student found guilty of gross misconduct may be asked to be withdrawn immediately from the school.

The following may be interpreted as constituting gross misconduct: -

- Truancy from either Assembly or class.
- Habitual Late coming.
- Shortage of Attendance.
- Indifference towards studies.
- Rudeness or Insubordination to the School Authorities.
- Cheating during a test or examination.
- Any other act that in any way harms the school property.

DISCIPLINE

The school management expects that children will abide by the rules and norms laid down from time to time for the betterment of the School. In the event of unacceptable indiscipline or insubordination, the School management and Principal will reserve the right to expel them from the School. Also, the Principal reserves the right to expel the child from the School in case of student's poor academic standards owing to any reason.
